

## How to reach the Elettra Laboratory from Venice Marco Polo Airport

### Location

Our laboratory is located in Basovizza, on the outskirts of Trieste, very close to the border with Slovenia.

<b>1. Head northwest on Viale Galileo Galilei</b>	<b>0.2 km</b>
<b>2. Turn left to stay on Viale Galileo Galilei</b>	<b>0.6 km</b>
<b>3. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit and stay on Viale Galileo Galilei</b>	<b>0.1 km</b>
<b>4. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on Viale Galileo Galilei</b> Go through 1 roundabout	<b>0.6 km</b>
<b>5. Slight right to stay on Viale Galileo Galilei</b>	<b>40 m</b>
<b>6. Slight right onto Via Triestina/SS14</b>	<b>0.8 km</b>

<b>7. Slight left onto Via Triestina</b>	<b>0.1 km</b>
<b>8. Turn left onto A27</b>	<b>5.0 km</b>
<b>9. Take the exit toward Trieste/Udine</b>	<b>1.0 km</b>

10.	Merge onto <b>A57</b> Partial toll road	4.8 km
11.	Continue onto <b>A4</b> Toll road	0.7 km
12.	Keep <b>right</b> at the fork, follow signs for <b>E70/A4/Trieste</b> and merge onto <b>A4/E70</b> Partial toll road	113 km
13.	Continue onto <b>E70</b> (signs for <b>Trieste</b> )	2.7 km
14.	Continue onto <b>SS202</b> (signs for <b>Trieste</b> )	8.6 km
15.	Continue onto <b>E70</b> (signs for <b>Trieste</b> )	7.2 km
16.	Continue onto <b>Raccordo Autostradale A4-Trieste</b> (signs for <b>Trieste</b> )	4.4 km
17.	Take the exit toward <b>Padriciano/Fiume</b>	0.2 km
18.	Slight <b>left</b> onto <b>Strada Statale 202</b> (signs for <b>Fiume/Basovizza</b> )	2.4 km
19.	Continue onto <b>SS202</b>	0.2 km
20.	Turn <b>right</b> toward <b>Strada per Basovizza/SR14</b> (signs for <b>Rijeka/Basovizza</b> )	34 m
21.	Turn <b>left</b> onto <b>Strada per Basovizza/SR14</b> (signs for <b>Trieste Centro</b> )	2.1 km
22.	Turn <b>left</b> onto <b>Strada per Basovizza</b>	0.9 km

## 2) Public transport

Unfortunately, there is no direct public transport connection from Venice airport to Trieste. The only way to get to Trieste is with the combination **bus - train - bus**.

### Step 1: bus from the airport to Venezia Mestre railway station.

Take the [ATVO](#) coach, in the direction towards Venezia-Mestre. The bus stop can be found just in front of the arrivals terminal. Tickets can be purchased online at the ATVO website or at the airport. The ATVO ticket office is located in the arrivals hall, box n. 80 and n. 81, and opens from 8.00 to 24.00. Tickets can also be bought from the 24-hour automatic ticket machine located outside the airport, in the ATVO departure bays. Ticket fare is € 5 (one way). Ride takes 20 min approximately, depending on traffic.

In alternative, there are local buses connecting Venice airport to Venezia Mestre railways station. Bus N. 15 ([ACTV](#)). Buses depart roughly every 30 minutes, check the timetable directly on the company's [website](#). Ticket fare: €5 (one way). Ride takes 40 min approximately. Tickets can be purchased at the airport's ticket office in the arrivals hall, open from 8.10 to 22.00.

### Step 2: train from Venezia Mestre railway station to Trieste.

The train stops at Trieste Centrale (last stop). Check [Trenitalia website](#) for timetables and fares (in the range € 10-15 for second class). Ride takes 1h 50' approximately.

### Step 3: From downtown Trieste to the Elettra Laboratory (Basovizza).

Once in Trieste, [you have to continue to Basovizza by bus](#) or by taxi (see the last page of this document).

## 3) By Taxi

Stop is located outside the passengers' terminal. Fare: To Trieste downtown around € 180. Ride takes 1h 30' approximately.

Ride takes 30 to 40 minutes, depending on traffic.

## Reaching the Elettra Laboratory by Bus from downtown Trieste

There are regular city service buses (N. 51 and 39) that travel from Trieste central railway station to the Elettra Laboratory or the village of Basovizza, which is about 10 km far from downtown Trieste. The bus stop can be found in Piazza della Libertà, the square facing the station (A), near the traffic light in front of the Unicredit bank (B). Tickets are €1.10 (one way) and can be bought in the newspaper kiosk or at the automatic ticket machine in the main square, in front of the railway station main entrance. It takes about 20 to 25 min to reach destination.

Note on Timetables: "Feriale" refers to a working day, "Festivo" to Sundays or National holidays (25/04, 1/05, 3/06, 1/11, 8/12) or City holidays (3/11). Note also that bus N. 39 stops in Basovizza (1.5 km from the lab) and only few rides reach Elettra.
